

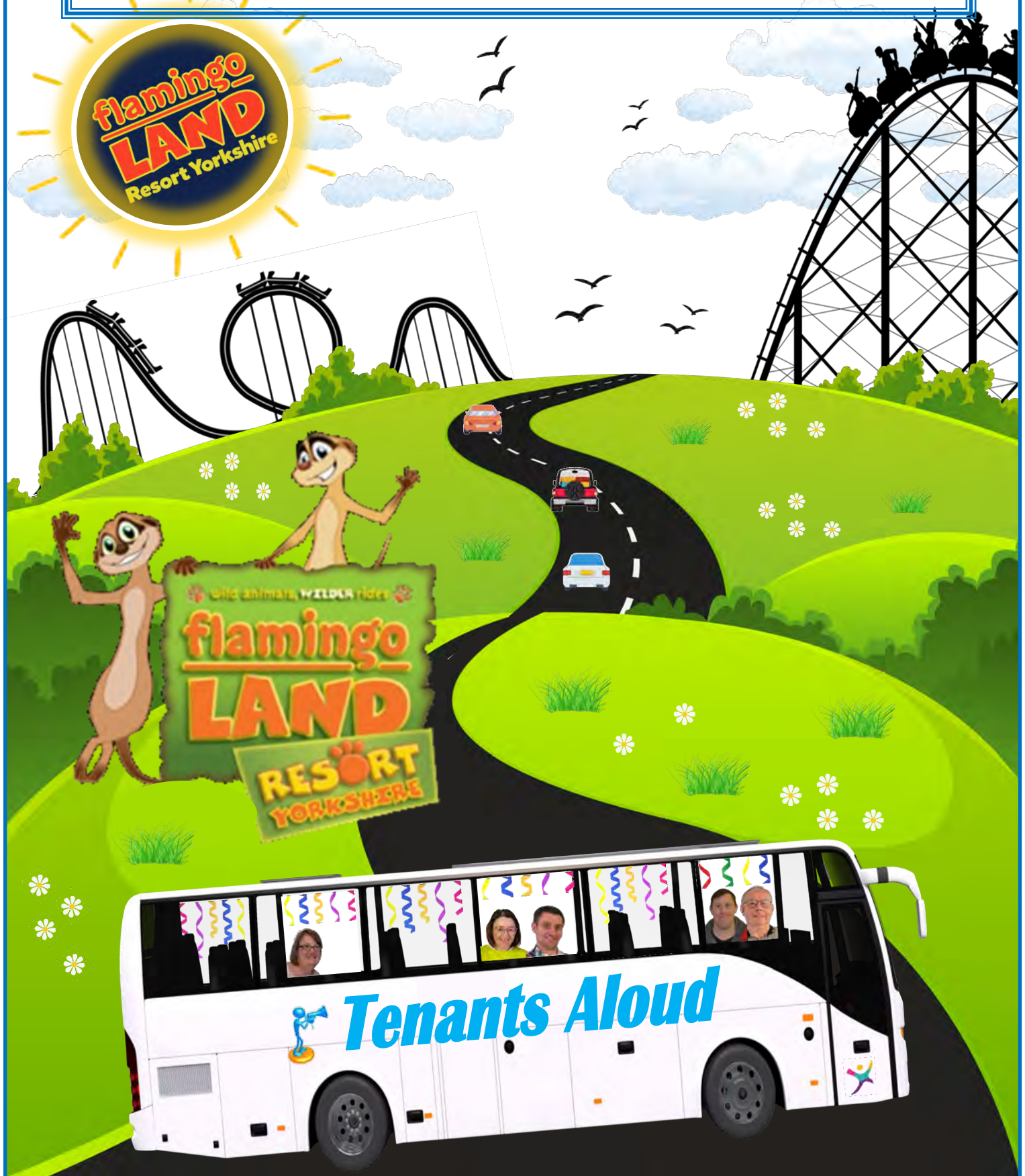

What a fantastic day we had at Music on the Green. It was another sunny day and the entertainers were amazing as always. It was a very bright and colorful day. Well done everyone!

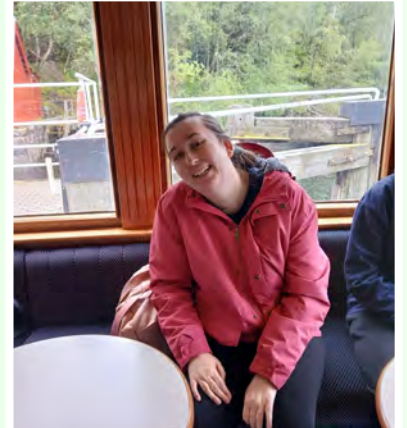
I am sure you will all agree the biggest **Thank You** goes to Anne Campbell, who works so hard at creating these amazing events.

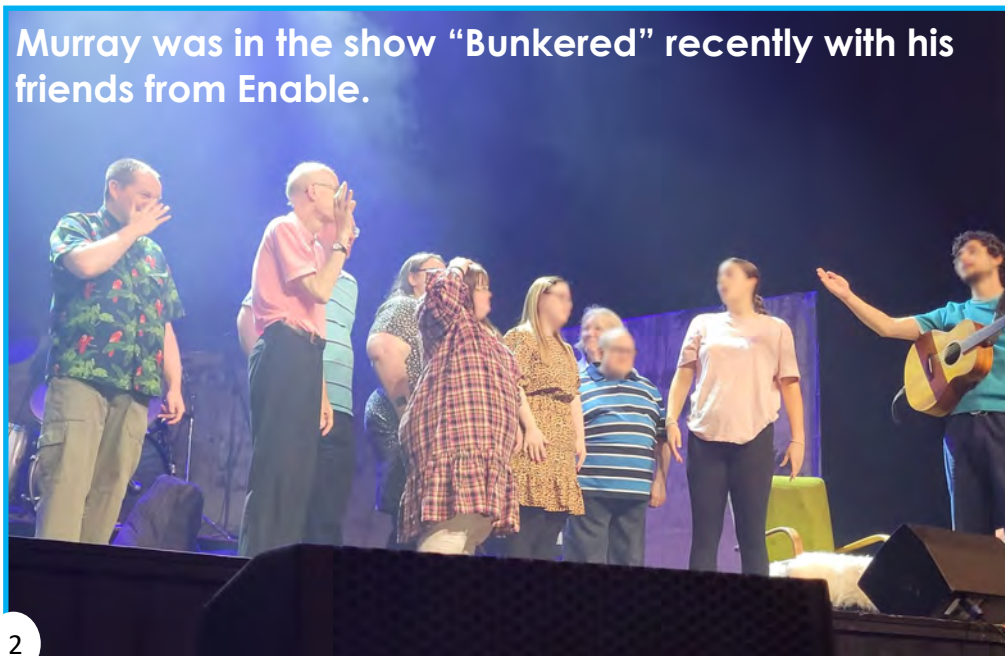

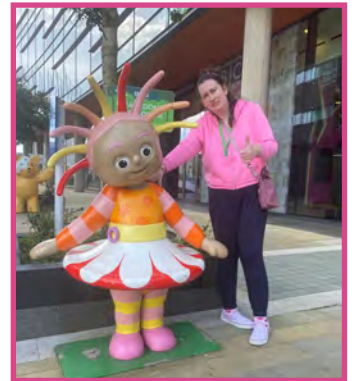
## My Trip to Manchester

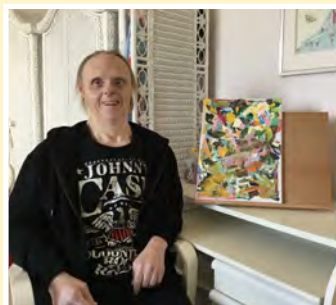
Jill celebrated her birthday with a party with all her friends!

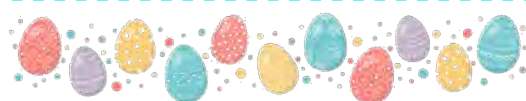
## • The Bungalow • It's been busy time at The Bungalow...

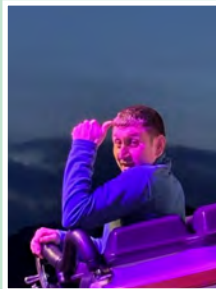

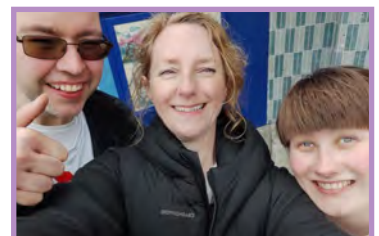
## Wizard of Oz, Edinburgh Playhouse

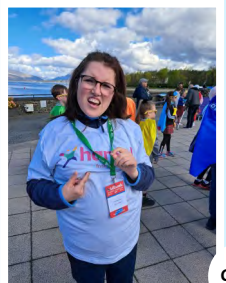
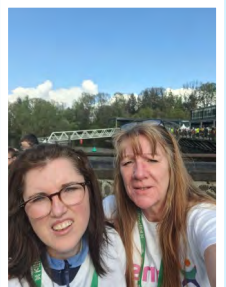
I love walking, seeing different places and meeting people, so my support worker Alison and I decided we would do the Kilt Walk together and raise money for Hansel.
