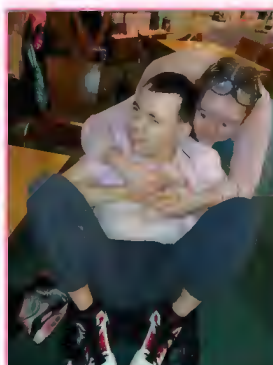
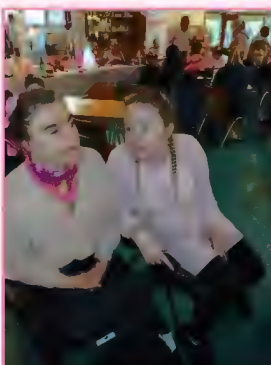


WEAR IT PINK AT HANSEL

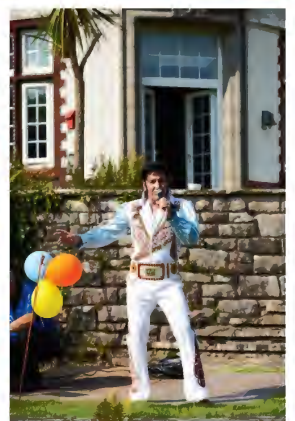
Everyone had a great afternoon and enjoyed lots of sweet treats, danced to music by DJ Dale and there was a prize raffle.

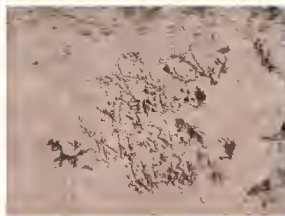

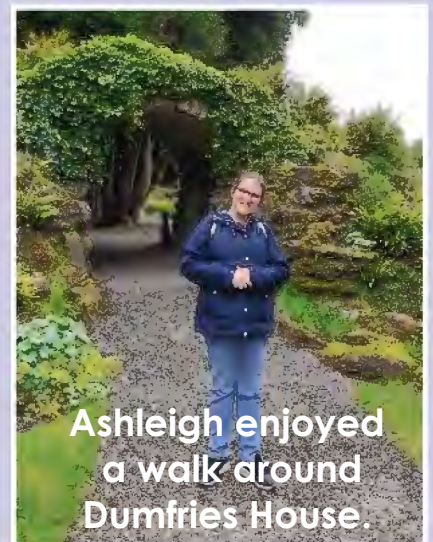
The Groovy Gang enjoyed a trip to Millport in July.

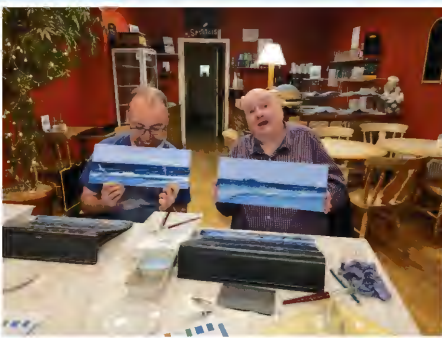




Graham and Andrew attended an art class which was held by local artist Caroline Dempsey.

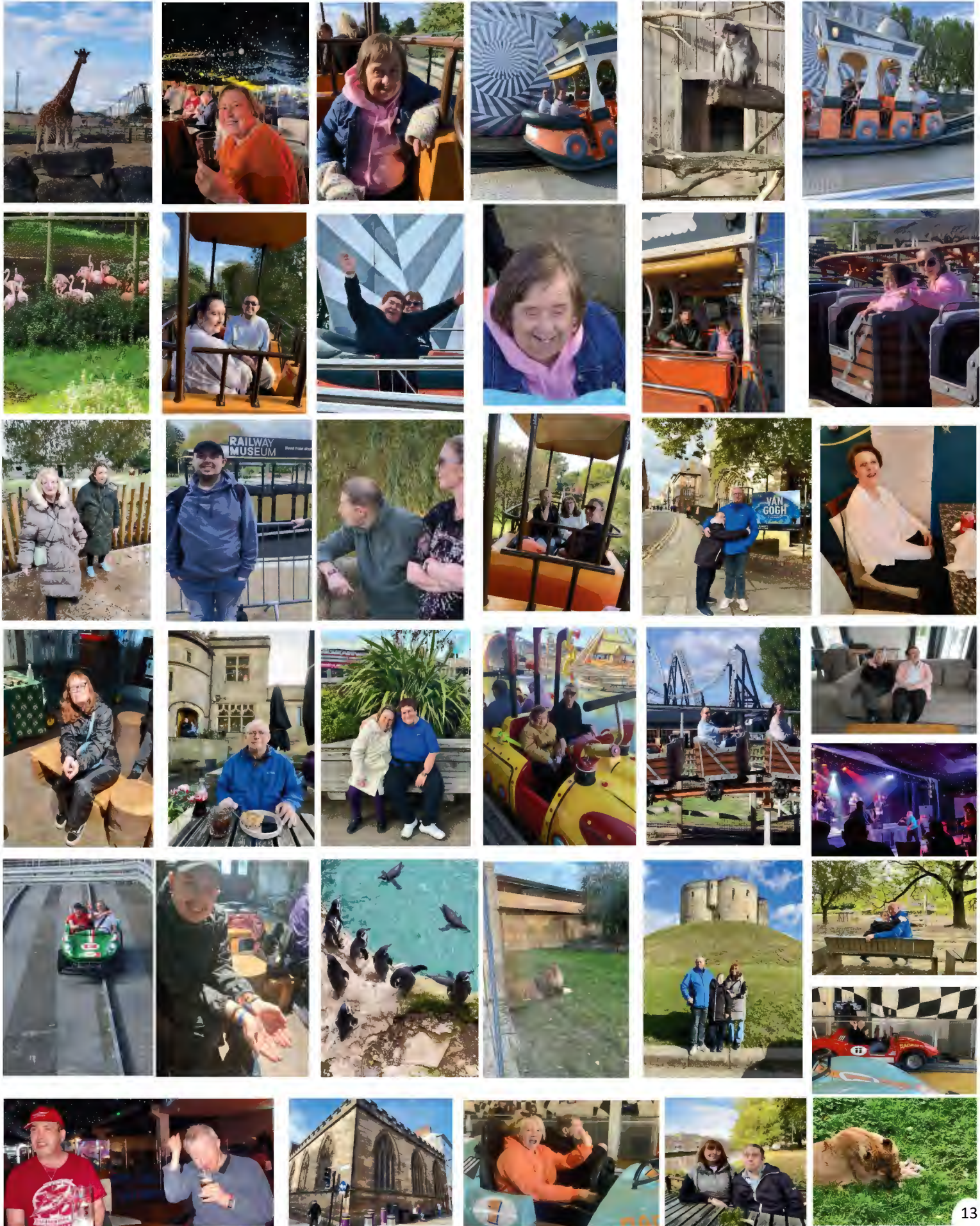

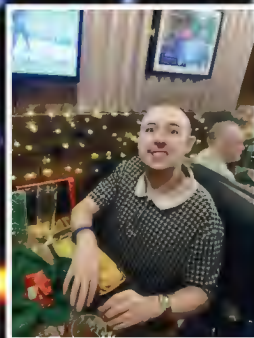
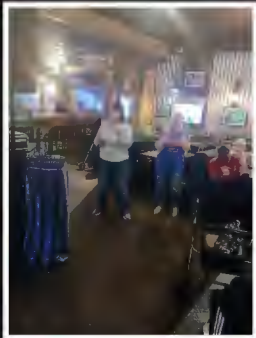
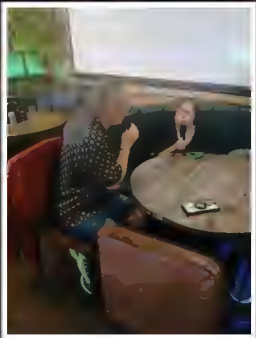
A trip abroad next, Spain, all inclusive or cruise!
