Terms and Conditions:

You can **NOT** participate if you are;

- Under 12 years old
- Pregnant
- Under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs

If any of the following apply, you **must** seek professional medical advice before participating and sign a non-standard waiver;

- High blood pressure
- Heart condition
- Suffer from dizziness or epilepsy
- Damage to neck, back, spinal column, legs or eyes
- Asthma
- Medication – if you are taking any form of prescribed medication, please inform us of how this may affect you
- Aged 50 years or above – we strongly advise that you seek medical advice prior to taking part

Places cannot be changed with another person. All places are non-refundable.

Waist harnesses fits waist size of 40 cm (15.7 inches) to 120 cm (47.2 inches).

Participants should be willing to ride in a man basket to the zip height of up to 150ft.

All participants enter the event entirely at their own risk. Hansel or the organisers shall not be liable for any injury or loss that might occur because of their participation. All participants are insured by the supplier and sign a waiver on the day.

The organiser takes all reasonable steps to minimise the risk of injury to participants during fundraising events. There is a stringent risk assessment process in place for each and every event which aims to minimise the risk to everyone taking part. However, by taking part in this event, you acknowledge that there may be conditions or circumstances beyond our control that can lead to unforeseen risks. If you have any concerns or queries please contact us before agreeing to take part in this event.

All participants must abide by any rules, instructions and regulations provided in advance, displayed or given on the day by the organiser and contracted agencies, police and officials.

If you have long hair, please be prepared to tie it up, it must remain out of the way for the duration of the zipline.

If you are unsure of your physical ability to take part in this event please contact us and we can liaise with the supplier and seek advice. Participants' supporters and family members who spectate at events do so entirely at their own risk. Hansel and the organisers shall not be liable for any injury or loss that might occur as a result of their attendance.

Hansel, the organiser and the host provider reserve the right to cancel or postpone the event if they consider there is an unacceptable risk (e.g. severe adverse weather) to the event participants, any staff or the general public. The host and organiser will then endeavour to move your participation to an alternative date for this event.

All transfers to and from the venue are at the participant's own expense.
