A few words from Janette..



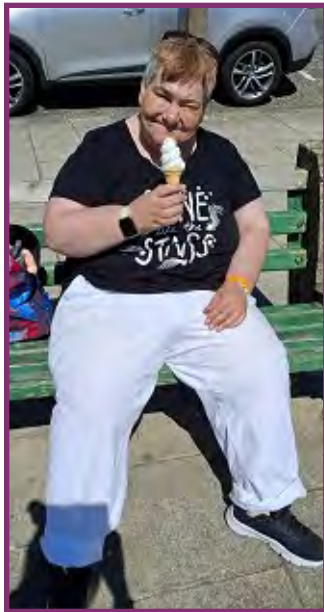
Hi everyone, it's summertime already, how quickly has this year gone!!

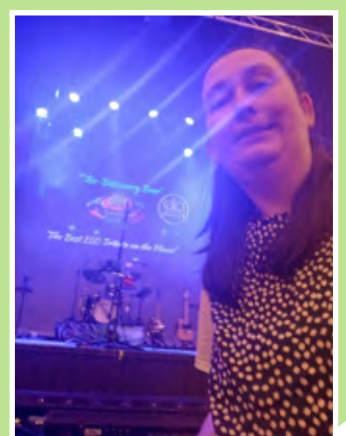

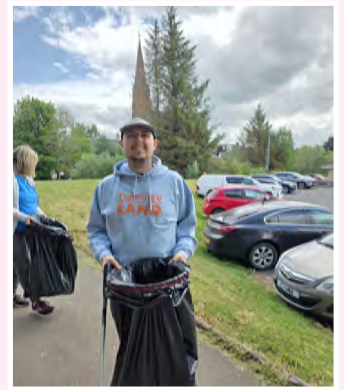

Fiona visited Northfield Park and left Easter stones that she had decorated and also went to see the swans.

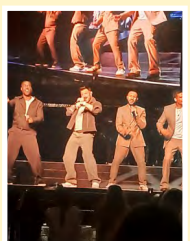
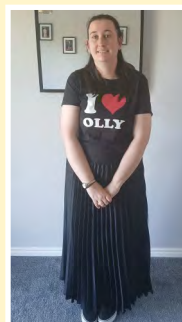

Pink Lemonade Recipe

Ingredients

8 lemons plus extra slices to serve
200g caster sugar plus extra to taste
140g raspberries plus extra to serve
Ice

Method

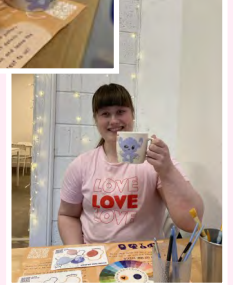
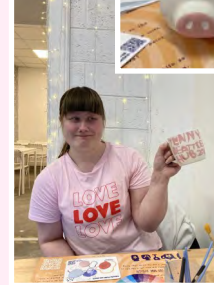
1. Pare the zest from the lemons with a peeler, removing as little white pith as possible – cut away any pith you can from the strips. 2. Juice the lemons and mix the juice, zest, sugar and raspberries with 1.2 litres of boiling water and let cool. 3. Sieve, pressing through juice with the back of a spoon. 4. Add sugar to taste and chill in jugs.

To serve, add a few lemon slices, raspberries and lots of ice.

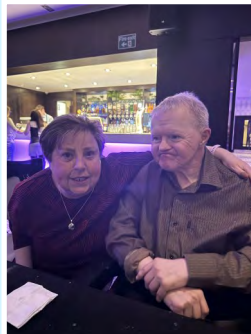

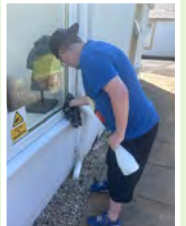
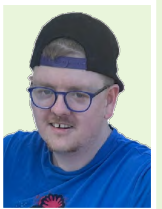


WHITELEYS RETREAT

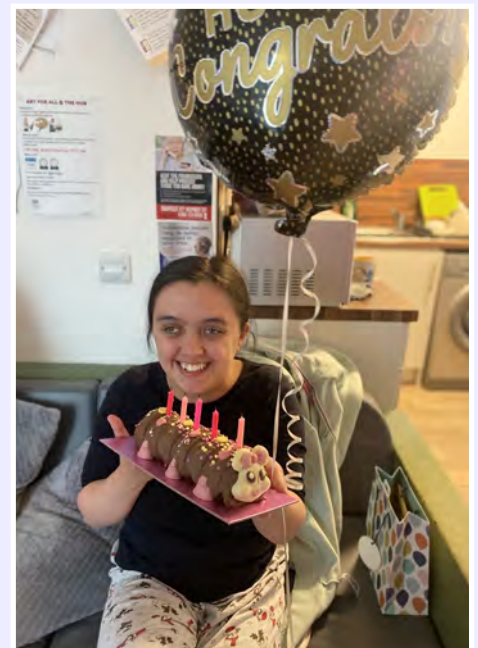

Ian took part in the Kilt Walk on the 27th of April. He completed three miles and raised over £100 for a local community.

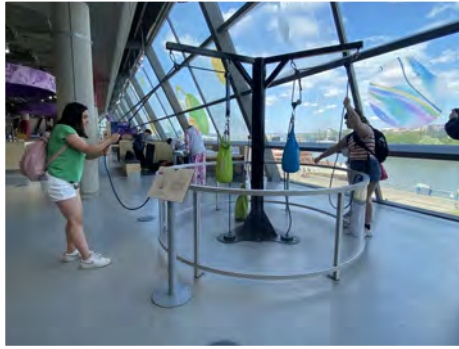

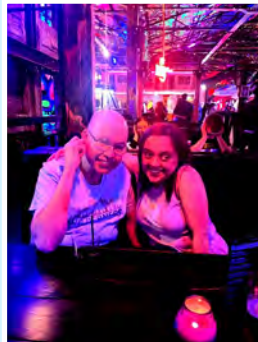

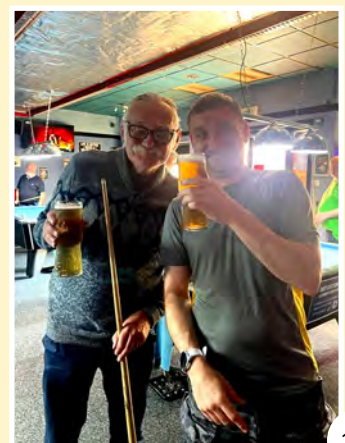
