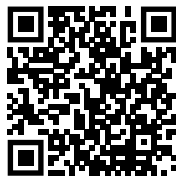

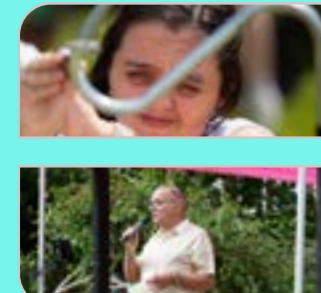

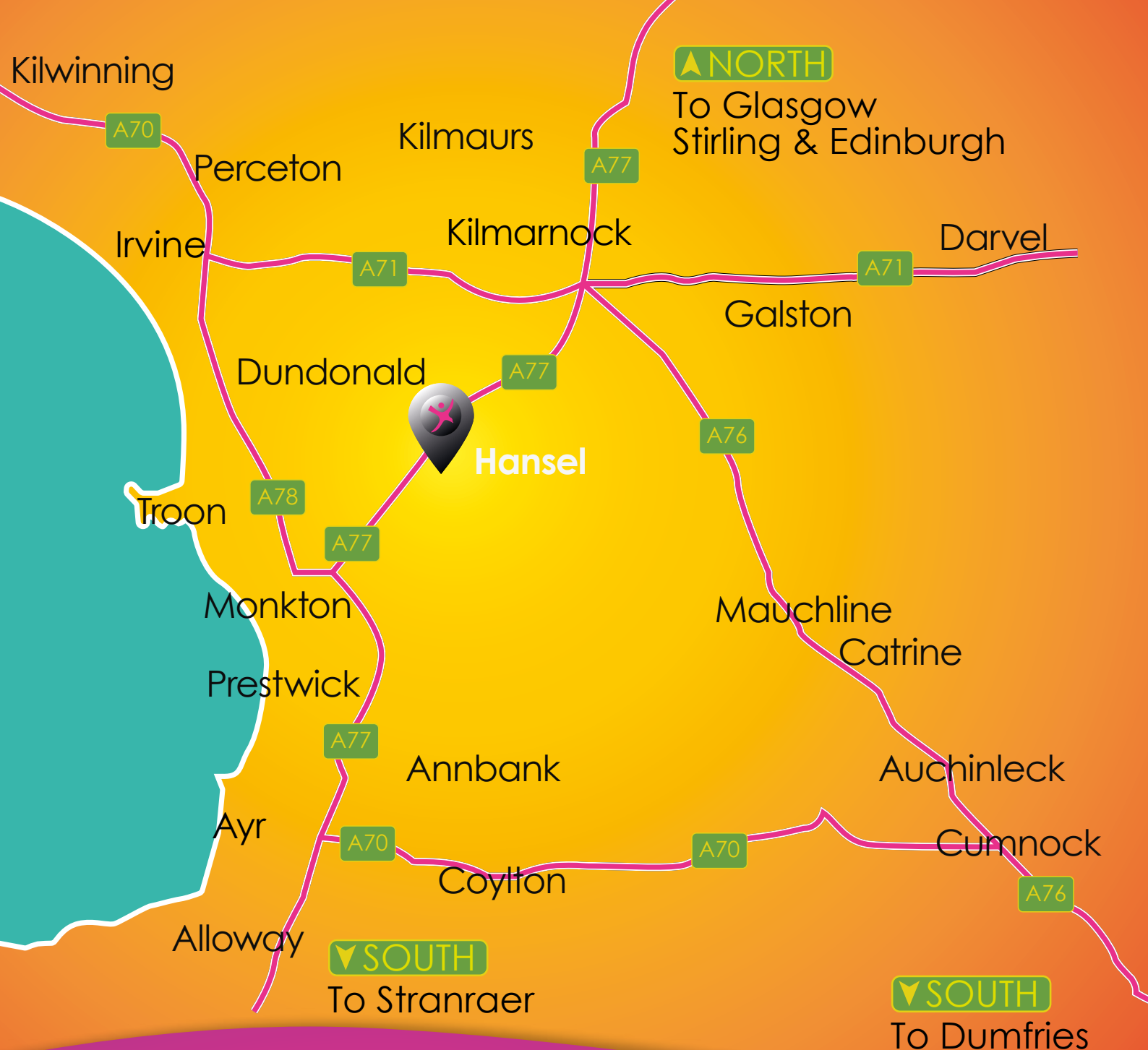


FUNDING THE BREAK
